SUBJECT: BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH (OCTOBER 2018)

BACKGROUND: In 1985, the month of October was designated as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month. In recognition of Breast Cancer Awareness Month in 2019, West Valley Water District is seeking to build a public awareness campaign designed to bring attention to the fight against breast cancer. The program includes participation from the Board of Directors, Executive Management, Employees and their families.

The awareness campaign entails West Valley Water District "Breast Cancer Awareness" shirts and vehicle magnets that will be utilized on district vehicles and incorporated into the outreach campaign for our ratepayers. In addition, the External Affairs Department is proposing to have a District Team participate in this year's "Breast Cancer Awareness Walk" in Rialto, California being held on October 5.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The District has supported numerous cancer-related organizations in recent years. However, the District is seeking to bring further awareness into issues facing our ratepayers including breast cancer. The Department is proposing to present a proclamation for consideration to the Board of Directors and have a breast cancer related nonprofit organization accept the proclamation.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Committee accept the information and direct staff to incorporate "Breast Cancer Awareness Month" throughout the month of October 2019.
