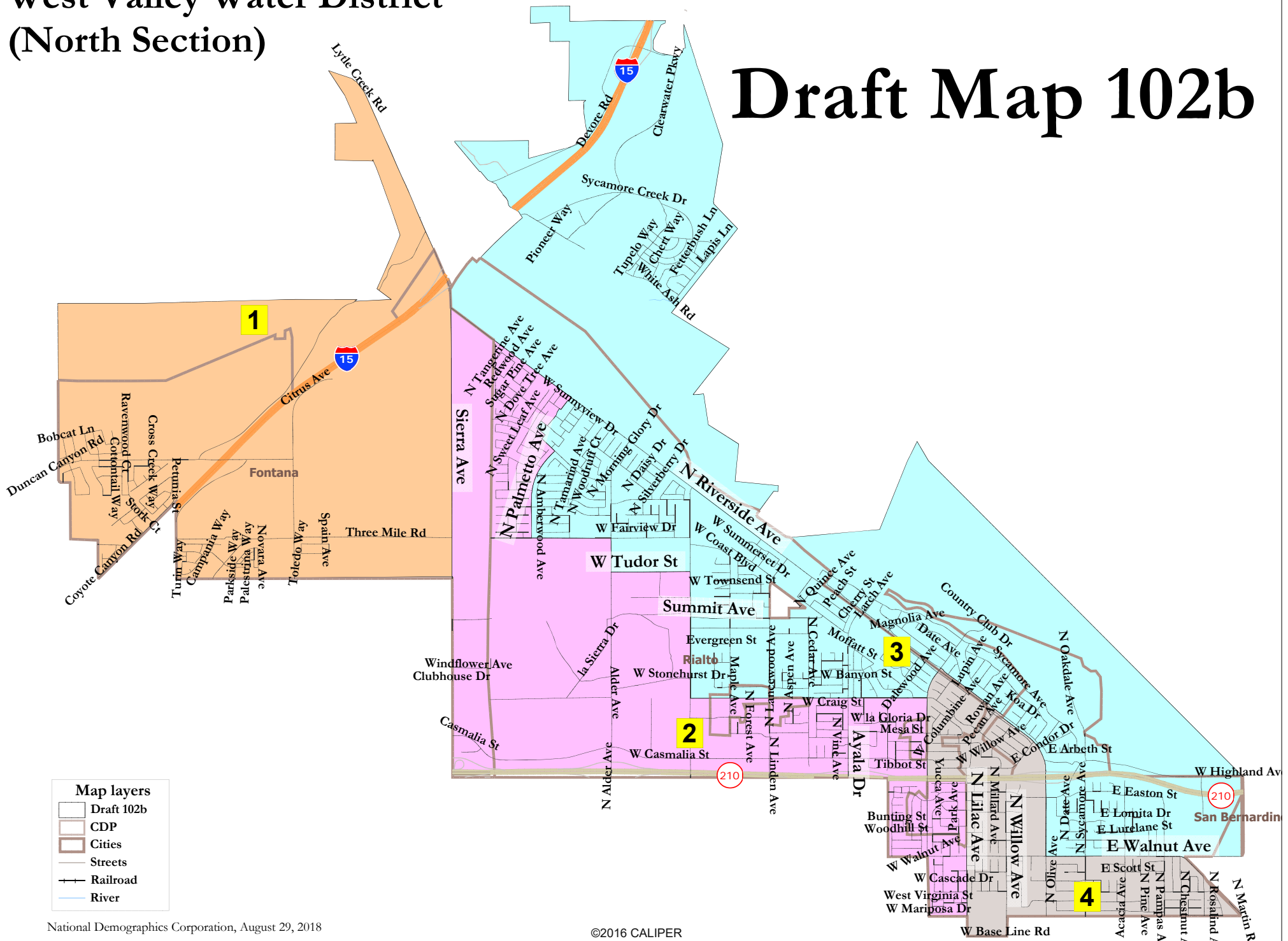


West Valley Water District (North Section)

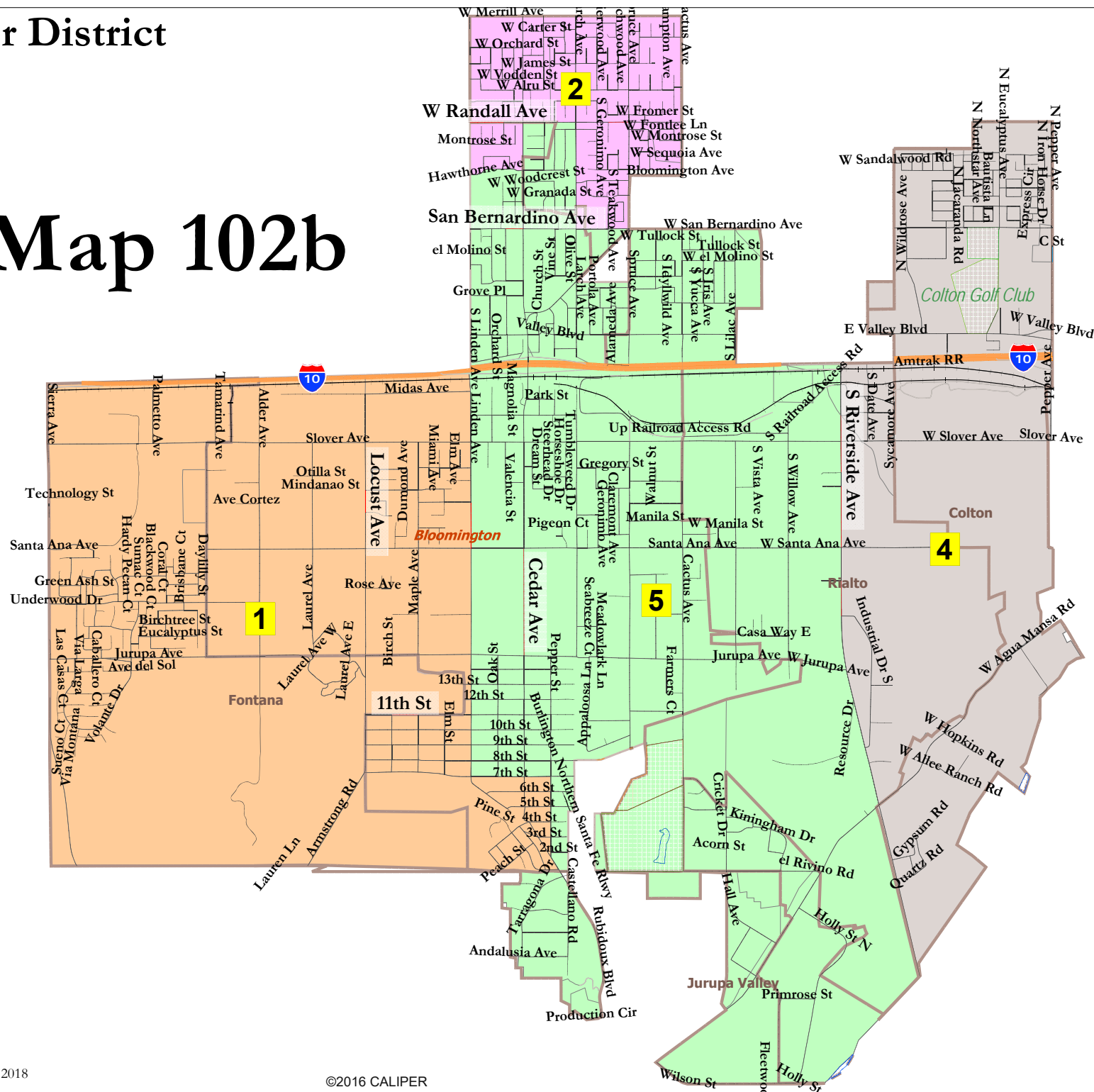
